The FDA has been working with several approved pharmaceutical companies since Spring to do the three phases of testing required in the United States. The requested releases are for several million doses and they will go to junior and senior populations first.

In Pennsylvania we follow the chain of command from the Governor to the PA Grand Master. This is well publicized in the Philadelphia media and Governor Wolf recently increased restrictions because of recent increases in COVID positive tests, full hospitals and confirmed deaths. LuLu Shrine has been very careful in its meetings with most meetings being remote ZOOM meetings. We are using that option as much as possible and will continue that until there is a significant decrease. That may take several months to determine if the finally approved vaccinations have a serious impact on declining COVID positive tests.

LuLu Shrine Temple is financially in excellent condition because we have reduced our budget and have had a great response from our Nobles volunteering for expensive services like mowing our lawns, plowing snow, painting and general maintenance on our great facility. Several retired Nobles come out every Wednesday to maintain the building and grounds. We have continued to increase rentals and have rescheduled events postponed because of COVID restrictions.

Across the Sights and Along the Lines of the LuLu Rod and Gun Club






