Our Fixers will take charge of the work moving through one room at a time. Once the work is completed it is imperative that the unit that occupies the room clean it up and make it presentable for show.

One of the things we no longer seem to do is show off our Unit Rooms. Wouldn't it be nice to change that for our next (or a future) Ceremonial? Perhaps candidates would be more interested in joining units if they could see some of the history and a more personal meeting space at LuLu.
