

# Parades - Are Units/Clubs Losing Interest?

LuLu's presence in parades is dwindling and units and clubs could be doing more to help make LuLu Shriners visible to the local population and at Shrine parades. There were only three units/clubs present with the Colonel of Units at the Rosemont parade on July 24, 2024, and one club needed support from other attendees to fill out their float. Such a significant change from prior times when we had Patrol in their uniforms, Lenape with their tent, Yacht club with their mini yacht (boat), Legion in their uniforms, Oriental Band with their music, Bucks with its big boat, LuLu's little motorized cars, or Mounted with their horses. Membership in LuLu has been declining, which impacts our units and clubs, but there are ways for them to still be involved in parades, even if it is only one representative. Let's start getting more participation so we can have a good parade presence in 2027 when Imperial holds its annual convention in Philadelphia!

Thanks go to those units/clubs that participated in the two Memorial Day parades and at Ocean City, NJ, where LuLu was showing itself off. They were Quaker City/Montco, Shepherds, NE Shrine Club, LuLu Klownz, Motor Unit, LuLu Shrine Float for riders, Divan members, and our Colonel of Units. They helped show LuLu is still active and has different activities to get some interest from others. Hope they continue to support parades and get more members out!

We do recognize the decline in our parade lineup is in part due to some units/clubs mentioned disbanding or have been reduced to few members or gave up their float used in parades. But that is still not an excuse for not having some participation as even a single unit/club member in uniform can parade. LuLu has

taken an unused club float and transformed it into a float for any who cannot walk the parade route or for single representatives from units/clubs or spouses and children of Shriners in local parades. If your unit/club has a float in the parade (not just a transportation vehicle) and the unit/club is a member of the UBA, your unit/club can be reimbursed for fuel and tolls to get to and from both local and long distant parades (such as MASA). If you need information on how your unit/club can participate and make its identity known to the public, contact the Potentate, divan, or the officers of the UBA.

#### So, let's see unit/club participation grow!

**Rod and Gun Club:** How about fishing for medical breakthroughs to help Shriners children?

**Scouts:** A tent on a truck or trailer with rep in scout uniform.

**Yacht Club:** Bbring back a boat as used previously in parades.

**Bucks Club:** Can something replace Crossing the Delaware such as a more canoe type float?

**Motor Unit:** Can we find members who can fit in the small, motorized cars to use them in parades?


**Stewards:** Float with a big pot hanging over fake fire and someone in cook's attire.

The Blue Team was the eventual winner of this contest. They were rewarded with a filet mignon deluxe dinner.




#### Other notable news from the Bicentennial:
