

A Global Mission of Shriners Shepherds

Fellow Shriners, we'd like to introduce you to Taghreed Wahhab and her son Shahm from Jordan. Bob Kostaras and I had the privilege of driving them today. Their story serves as a powerful reminder of the precious, worldwide mission we undertake every day as Shepherds.

Shahm, now on his fifth visit to Shriners Children's Philadelphia Hospital, has undergone extensive operations on his legs, hands, and spine. His mother, Taghreed, shared with us her amazement at her son's progress and her profound gratitude for the care they've received.

"I've been so blessed by Shriners," Taghreed told us.
"My son has had the finest medical care in the world
- care we could never afford on our own. I can't thank
the Shriner organization enough."

As Shepherds, our role extends far beyond simple transportation. Many times, we are the first point of contact for families, offering not just a ride, but a warm welcome to children and families from around the globe. Taghreed expressed her gratitude that we were volunteers, not paid drivers. Bob responded by telling her that the work was its own payment, and it was priceless. This sentiment deeply moved Taghreed, as she understood the impact of our collective efforts.

Tomorrow, Taghreed and Shahm will return to Jordan with a brand-new motorized wheelchair – a life-changing device that Shahm would not have access to in his



home country. This moment crystallizes the gravity and global reach of our mission. As Taghreed noted, this wheelchair will be immensely helpful for her son, allowing him a level of independence that would have been unattainable without Shriners' intervention.

This experience reinforces why we do what we do. It's not just about getting patients to their appointments; it's about being part of a larger, international mission to change lives and offer hope to families like Taghreed and Shahm's. We bridge cultures, cross language barriers, and connect these families to the life-changing care they need.




Lulu Supports Yachtstock River Jam – Benefits Shriners Hospitals

THE HISTORY OF THE SHRINE & LULU TEMPLE – 16 CHAPTER CXII (112) – HISTORY OF THE FEZ



A look back at the 100th Anniversary (1884 - 1984) Fraternal Year Highlights:

The Fraternal Year in 1984 captured LuLu's 100th year. The theme for the year was "Fun Galore In 84." Lulu Temple was the 16th temple to receive a charter from the Imperial Council. The original charter date is June 2, 1884.

The first order of business happened on January 5, 1984, when the Potentate, Noble Albert W. Hibbert, installed all the officers of the Quaker City Shrine Cub. Two days later, he installed all the Officers of the Uniformed Units during a night of dinner and dancing.

The meeting in March was dubbed "Blu Lodge Night" when the Nobles were encouraged to bring their Blue Lodge Brothers as their guests.
