



Hillbillies of Clan #12





Well, here we are summer is halfway over. The year is flying by faster than I ever thought possible. Great things are happening here at Shriners Children's Philadelphia.

In the May issue of the Philadelphia Magazine four of our doctors here at Shriners Hospital Philadelphia were named Top Doctors for 2025. They are Dr. Dan A. Zlotolow, Dr. Scott H. Kozin, Dr. Amer F. Samdani and Dr. Joshua M. Pahys. Congratulations to all these wonderfully talented and extremely dedicated doctors. Doctors Pahys and Samdani are leaders in fusionless spinal surgery for the treatment of scoliosis, while Doctors Kozin and Zlotolow are pioneers in the care of upper extremities. These four doctors are the best in the world, and we are extremely blessed to have them on our team here at Shriners Children's - Philadelphia.

As Shriners, we all should be humbled and proud to know that our hospital here in Philadelphia has several world-renowned doctors on staff. That is what makes us the best around.

Over the weekend of May 15th thru May 18th our doctors, nurses and technical staff traveled to Porto Rico for another very successful outreach clinic.

The numbers of patients that are being seen at this clinic continue to increase. At the previous clinic in November, they treated just over 200 patients. At this May clinic they saw and treated just over 400 patients. The families come from all over the island to have their children treated and as word spreads,

the number of patients continues to increase.

In November our Doctors and staff will be traveling to Porto Rico again for another clinic. So far they have more than 250 appointments scheduled. Also, later this year, there is a clinic scheduled to travel to Cyprus. This will be the second clinic that has gone there, and as you can well imagine, the number of patients is also increasing as the word spreads of the work our medical team does for these children. We should all be very proud of the care we provide here in Philadelphia and around the world.

On Sunday July 27 the Centurions held their 29th Christmas in July toy run for the children here at our Philadelphia Hospital. As you can well imagine it was a huge success.


